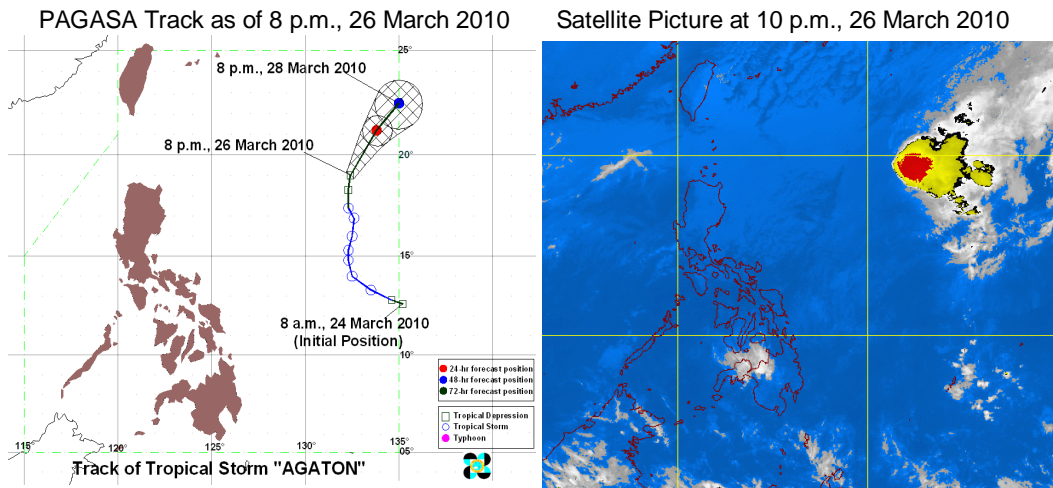

Tropical Depression "AGATON" has maintained its strength as it moves farther away from the country.



Location of Center: (as of 10:00 p.m.)	1,010 km East of Aparri, Cagayan
Coordinates:	19.1°N, 132.5°E
Strength	Maximum sustained winds of 55 kph near center
Movement	North Northeast at 11 kph
Forecast Position	<i>Saturday evening:</i> 1,160 km East Northeast of Aparri, Cagayan 1,080 km East of Basco, Batanes <i>Sunday evening:</i> 1,210 km East Northeast of Basco, Batanes
No public storm warning signal was raised.	


