Tropical Storm "BASYANG" has weakened slightly as it moves in a northwest direction.

Location of Center: (as of 4:00 P.M.)	180 km West of Iba, Zambales
Coordinates:	15.7°N, 118.2°E
Strength:	Maximum sustained winds of 85 kph near the center and gustiness of up to 100 kph
Movement:	Northwest at 19 kph
Forecast Positions/Outlook:	Tropical Storm "BASYANG" will be at 480 km West of Laoag City tomorrow afternoon.

Areas Having Public Storm Warning Signal

Public Storm Warning Signals elsewhere are now lowered.

Residents living in low-lying and near coastal areas and near mountain slopes under signal no. 1 are advised to take all the necessary precautionary measures against flashfloods and landslides.

The public and the disaster coordinating councils concerned are advised to take appropriate actions.


In order to better inform/warn communities, you are reminded to disseminate these through local/community leaders and through your local media, including community radio stations. Conduct press briefings as often as needed. This local effort will complement and reinforce efforts at the national level. Emphasis should be on proactive actions – evacuation rather than rescue.
