Tropical Storm "BASYANG" moves farther away from the country.

Location of Center: (as of 4:00 A.M.)	400 km West Northwest of Dagupan City
Coordinates:	16.7°N, 116.3°E
Strength:	Maximum sustained winds of 85 kph near the center and gustiness of up to 100 kph
Movement:	Northwest at 19 kph
Forecast Positions/Outlook:	Tropical Storm "BASYANG" will be at 720 km West Northwest of Laoag City tomorrow morning.

With this development, this is the final bulletin for this weather disturbance.


