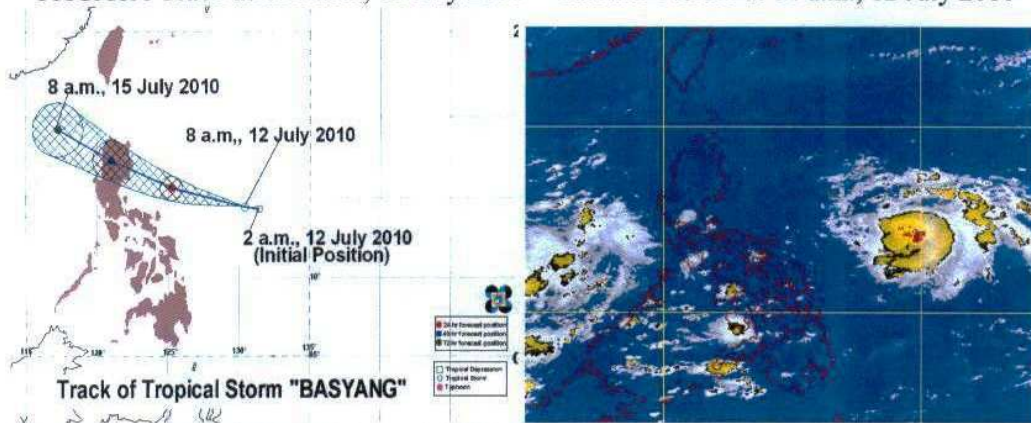

<b>Location of Center: (as of 10:00 a.m.)</b>	570 km East Northeast of Virac, Catanduanes
<b>Coordinates:</b>	14.4°N, 130.0°E
<b>Forecast Positons</b>	It is expected to be at <b>220 km North Northeast of Virac, Catanduanes</b> by tomorrow morning. It is expected to make a landfall over <b>Isabela-Northern Aurora tomorrow night</b> and will be at <b>50 km East of Sinait, Ilocos Sur</b> by Wednesday morning. By Thursday morning, it will be at <b>320 kms West Northwest of Laoag City.</b>
