I. SITUATION OVERVIEW

A, Chronology of Basyang

12 July 2010

- ❖ 4:00 AM - the low pressure area (LPA) East of Visayas had intensified into a Tropical Depression and was named "Basyang" located at 660 km East Northeast (ENE) of Virac, Catanduanes or 14.4°N, 131.0°E and with maximum center winds of 55 kph
- ❖ 10:00 AM - TD Basyang had intensified into a Tropical Storm (TS) as it moved towards Northern Luzon area located at 570 km ENE of Virac, Catanduanes or 14.4°N, 131.0°E (65 kph)
- ❖ 4:00 PM - it intensified further as it moved towards northern Luzon area located at 440 km ENE of Virac, Catanduanes or 14.3°N, 128.7°E (75 kph)
- ❖ 10:00 PM - it gained more strength as it continued to move towards Isabela Area located at 320 km East of Virac, Catanduanes or 14.5°N, 127.4°E (95 kph)

13 July 2010

- ❖ 4:00 AM - further intensified as it moved towards Isabela-Aurora area located at 190 km ENE of Virac, Catanduanes or 14.6°N, 126.2°E (114 kph)
- ❖ 10:00 AM - TS Basyang intensified into a typhoon as it moved towards Aurora-Northern Quezon area located at 90 km North of Virac, Catanduanes or 14.3°N 124.4°E (120 kph)
- ❖ 4:00 PM - Typhoon Basyang maintained its strength as it moved towards Aurora and Northern Quezon area located at 40 km or 14.4°N, 123.3°E (120 kph)
- ❖ 11:00 PM - it weakened as it made landfall over Northern Quezon located in the vicinity of Infanta, Quezon or 14.8°N, 121.9°E (95 kph)

14 July 2010

- ❖ 4:00 AM - TS Basyang crossed Luzon located at 90 km West of Metro Manila or 14.6°N, 120.1°E (95 kph)
- ❖ 10:00 AM - it maintained its strength as it moved away from the country
- ❖ 4:00 PM - Tropical Storm Basyang moved farther away from the country
- ❖ 10:00 PM - it continued to move away from the country located at 290 km West of Dagupan City or 16.2°N, 117.3°E (85 kph)

15 July 2010 (Final)

- ❖ 4:00 AM - TS Basyang moved farther away from the country (85 kph)

B. OVER ALL ASSESSMENT

Typhoon Basyang is the first typhoon in 2010 that crossed the mainland. However, its effects in terms of population affected, casualties and damages are very minimal compared to the effects of Tropical Storm "Ondoy" in 2009.

The strength of TS Ondoy was only 105 kph, however, prior to its landfall near the boundary of Aurora and Quezon, it brought more rainfall enhanced by southwest monsoon which caused widespread flooding in most part of Metro Manila, Southern and Central Luzon as well as other parts of the Visayas and Mindanao while Typhoon Basyang was 120 kph but it did not bring more rainfall. Hence, resulting minimal destruction except in five (5) provinces of Region IV-A which suffered the brunt in terms of population, affecting 23,481 families or 115,461 persons in 327 barangays of 51 municipalities with minimal number of population displacement 1,160 families or 5,511 persons who evacuated to 41 evacuation centers.

Only four (4) regions were affected by Typhoon Basyang: Regions III (Aurora, Bataan, Bulacan and Pampanga); IV-A (Rizal, Cavite, Laguna, Quezon and Batangas); V (Camarines Sur, Camarines Norte and Catanduanes); and NCR (cities of Muntinlupa, Pateros and Manila). Affected municipalities in Region IV-A were the same municipalities affected by Typhoon Ondoy in 2009.

The Rapid Damage and Needs Assessment (RDANA) teams of RDCCs III, IV-A, V and MMDA are still conducting DANA in their respective areas of responsibility to determine the actual effects of said weather disturbance. It is therefore expected that figures on Typhoon Basyang will still increase.

C. SUMMARY OF THE EFFECTS

1. Affected Population (Tab A)

- ❖ As of reporting time, the total number of population affected in **411** barangays of **9** cities and **63** municipalities in **12** provinces of Regions III, IV-A, V and NCR **remains the same** at **30,644** families or **153,426** persons
- ❖ **Sixty two (62)** evacuation centers were utilized as temporary shelter to **2,145** families or **10,390** persons. As of reporting time **1,757** families or **8,918** persons are still housed inside **51** evacuation centers.

2. Casualties (Tab B)

- ❖ **Dead** – 39 (13 in Region III; 21 in Region IV-A; 5 in Region V)
- ❖ **Missing** – 84 (3 in Region III; 31 in Region IV-A; 49 in Region V; 1 in Region VI)
- ❖ **Injured** – 18 (2 in Region III; 12 in Region IV-A; 4 in Region V)

3. Damages

a. Houses (Tab C)

- ❖ The total number of damaged houses in Regions III, IV-A and V **remains the same** at **18,658** (2,591 totally and 16,067 partially)

b. Infrastructure

Region III

- Breakwater structure at Brgy Poblacion, Mariveles, Bataan was damaged

Region IV-A

- Sinisian Bridge along Palico-Balayan-Batangas Road due to scoured slope protection (PhP 10M) and two (2) road slips near Diokno Highway (PhP 5M)
- Tayabas-Mainit-Mauban Road Road slip reported (PhP1.80 M)

Region IV-B

- Manus Bailey Bridge I along Labangan Murtha Junction Iriron Road Brgy Batasan, San Jose in Occidental Mindoro - damaged in Approach B (PhP 585,000)

Region V

- Inalmasinan Spillway Km 148+650 along Caramoan, Catanduanes Road washed-out section (PhP50,000,000)
- DepEd conducted immediate assessment and reported that 23 schools in Region IV-A (3 elementary schools, 3 high schools; IV-B (2 ES); V (8 HS); and NCR (7 ES) have been damaged with estimated cost of PhP 4.87 M

c. Cost of Damages (Tab D)

- The estimated cost of damage to infrastructure, agriculture, fisheries and schools in Regions IV-A, V and NCR **remains the same** at PhP 147.556 M
- 71,274 metric tons of vegetables, valued at P 1.398 M was lost from 207 hectares in the province of Laguna
- Eight (8) fishing vessels in Region III were totally damaged due to huge waves
- There were 941 hectares planted with various crops were damaged (papaya, rambutan, lanzones, banana, corn) in the municipalities of Sta. Cruz, Sta. Maria, Mabitac, Pila and Sta. Maria, all of Laguna

d. Cost of Assistance (Tab E)

- Cost of assistance provided by DSWD, DOH and LGUs is estimated at **PhP420,625**

e. Emergency Incidents

Maritime Incidents

- Between 4:00 am and 5:00 am on 14 July, LPG Carrier “Deborah Uno” sank while in the vicinity of Mariveles, Bataan due to strong currents and big waves. The captain of the tanker, Efren S Ledesma, was found dead on the shore of Brgy Lamao, Limay, Bataan. The eight (8) survivors from the barge are identified as follows: Jessie P Alamario, 59 y/o from Malabon City; Rolando T Billones from Malabon City; Victor Glenn Mariposque y Luna, 38 y/o from Cebu City; Dennis Ramos y Revilla, 32 y/o from Malabon; Arcel Fernandez y Navalta, 32 y/o from Binondo, Manila; Jorlan Dupio y Talon, 29 y/o from Parañaque; Mario D Francisco, 35 y/o from Iloilo City; and Marvin Espino y Paule, 34 y/o, Brgy San Pablo, Dinalupihan, Bataan
- Fishing vessel Alicia A/C sank in the vicinity of Mariveles, Bataan resulting in the death of every one in its crew of six (6)
- Fifty two (52) other vessels of varied types were destroyed, run aground, capsized, or half-submerged in different places in Bataan.
- Three (3) fishing boats with a total of 39 persons on board capsized due to strong winds. There were 18 survivors, 3 recovered bodies and 18 missing. NFSL, 2ID, PA have been directed to conduct SAR operations in the vicinity of Balesin Island, Polillo, Quezon
- Tugboat “Side Winder” with nine (9) crew onboard encountered trouble in the vicinity of San Nicolas Shoal. Prior to the incident, said tugboat was towing a barge which had sunk six (6) NM NNW off Sangley Pt., Cavite City. At 10:00 AM 14 July, PCG Search and Rescue Vessel (SARV) 002 arrived in the area and picked-up the 2 injured and 1 fishermen (identified as Ninio Ambrosio).
- Eleven (11) fishermen in Brgy Sukdan, Bagamanoc, Catanduanes went fishing on July 12, 2010 aboard three (3) motorized bancas off the Pacific waters east of Bagamanoc and, having failed to return home due to bad weather conditions, were declared missing.
- Eight (8) fishermen in Pandan, Catanduanes who were earlier reported missing have been recovered and admitted at Pandan District Hospital

3.6 Status of Lifelines

Power Interruptions

- **NCR** - some portions of Quezon City, Balintawak, Diliman, Kamuning; Duhat, Balintawak, Sucat substations have been energized.
- **Region I** – fully restored
- **Region III** – 80% of power has been restored in Central Luzon
- **Region V** – no power in the whole province of Camarines Norte
- As of 14 July, National Grid Corporation of the Philippines (NGCP) has restored transmission power load in the following sub-grids: Batangas-Ibaan-Rosario (46.67 %); Batangas-Lima Land (63%); Calaca (37.50%); Damariñas-Abubot-Rosario (9.30%); Dasmariñas 34.5 KV F1 (100%); Gumaca-Tagkawayan-Quezon (28%); Gumaca 69KV L (48.57%); Los Baños (50%); Makdan-Los Baños (57.14%); and Makban-Calamba (23.33%)

- During the NDCC Emergency Meeting held on 14 July 2010, DOE reported that strong winds caused the tripping of the north-to-south transmission backbone of the NGCP.

Roads and Bridges

- Major roads and bridges in Regions I, II, III, IV-A, IV-B, V and NCR are passable to all types of vehicles except the following:

Region IV-A

Sinisian Bridge along Palico-Balayan-Batangas Road **not passable** due to scoured slope protection (Detour Road: Diokno Highway for light vehicles only and Manila-Batangas Road for all types of vehicles)

Region IV-B

Manus Bailey Bridge I along Junction Labangan-Murtha-Iriron Road Brgy Batasan, San Jose in Occidental Mindoro - passable only to motor cycles and tricycles (due to washed out slope section)

II. HUMANITARIAN RESPONSE

A. National

- ❖ NDCC Emergency Meeting with President Benigno Simeon Aquino III was held at the National Disaster Management Center, Camp Aguinaldo at 8:30 AM on 14 July 2010. Member agencies apprised the President on the situation and actions taken in response to the effects of TY “Basyang”. Among his directives were the following:
 - PAGASA-DOST to review what happened in the trajectory of TY Basyang and come up with lesser deviation on future weather forecasts
 - DILG to conduct inventory of areas affected by the typhoon, account for vulnerable people, and ensure that needs of affected population are attended/provided for
 - PCG to come up with a “recall system” for fishermen at sea during weather disturbance
 - Concerned agencies to ensure the safe return of evacuees especially to potentially hazard areas
- On 14 July, President Aquino and DSWD-NCR staff visited the evacuees at the Baseco and Delpan Sports Complex in Manila and distributed 180 family packs and 180 Saudi mats
- DILG identified the following needs of the affected LGUs: Laguna (additional rescue boats) and Camarines Norte (relief and rescue operation in relation to reports about missing fishermen. Also reported two (2) isolated cases of evacuation in the coastal areas in Bataan (with 2 evacuation centers in Mariveles, Bataan)
- DSWD prepositioned PhP106.14 M standby funds and PhP135.78 M worth of relief supplies (PhP 241.92 M total) in all DSWD Field Offices in Regions III, IV-A, V, NCR and DSWD National Resource Operation Center (NROC)

B. Local

- ❖ BFP rescued 7 persons trapped in the flooded area at Brgy Halang, Calamba, Laguna
- ❖ SAR operation by the PN (NAVFORSOL), Phil Air Force (505SARG/207THS) and Phil Coast Guard-Bicol Station conducted on 14 July to assist local SAR teams in Catanduanes on board 2 PAF Aircraft (Huey), was called-off due to unfavourable weather condition
- ❖ PN Vessel (PG374) with personnel from NAVSOU returned to Tabaco Port in Albay due to unfavourable sea condition
- ❖ PN Islander Aircraft (BN311) was dispatched from Sangley Point Cavite to Legazpi City on 14 July, to assist in the SAR operation
- ❖ TOG5 helicopters conducted SAR mission in the vicinity of Calagua Island, Vinzon, Camarines Norte on 14 July.
- ❖ DPWH, MMDA, AFP Engineering Brigade, BFP, PNP and LGUs conducted clearing operations along the roads and highways blocked by fallen trees, falling rocks and toppled electric posts in affected areas
- ❖ BFP has been conducting water rationing and assisting in bringing affected families to the evacuation areas
- ❖ DSWD Field Office (FO)-V extended 1,000 family packs worth PhP150,000 to the affected families of Siruma, Camarines Sur
- ❖ Provincial Disaster Management Office (PDMO) Camarines Sur deployed 3 teams for 1st District, 2nd District and Rinconada areas to assess any landslide and flooding occurrences
- ❖ OCD V Regional Director with Gov. Tallado, AFP, PN and PCG conducted aerial survey in the Province of Camarines Norte on 14 July 2010
- ❖ Regional Director of OCD-V with NFSL, PCGD Bicol, TOG5 personnel and local media conducted damage assessment and needs analysis (DANA) in Catanduanes, Camarines Sur and Camarines Norte
