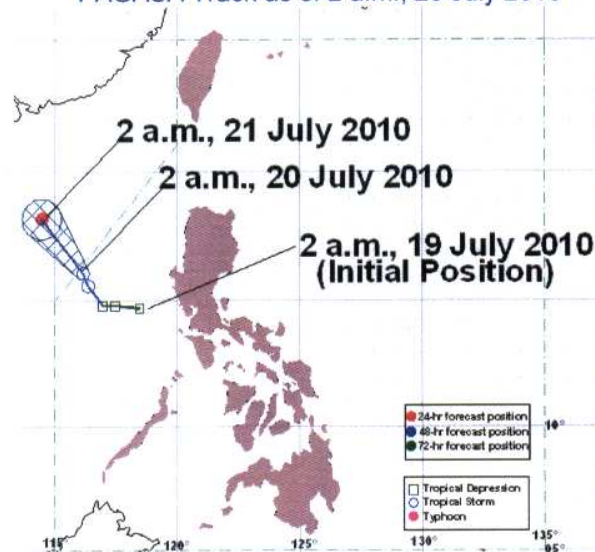

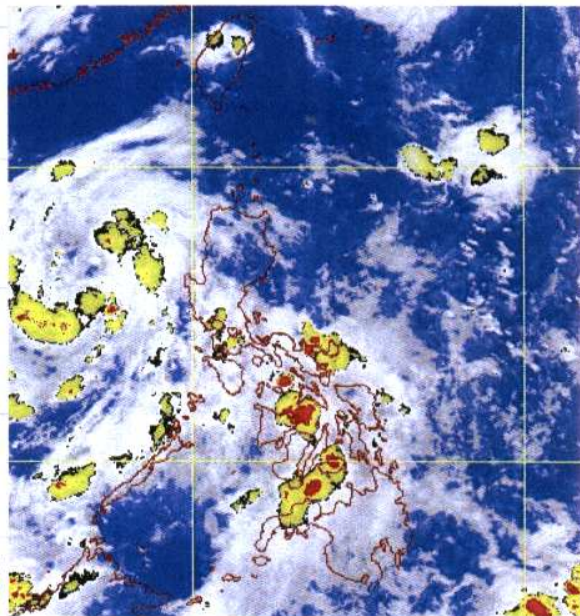

Location of Center: (as of 4:00 A.M.)	420 km West Northwest of Dagupan City
Coordinates:	16.3°N, 116.0°E
Strength	Maximum sustained winds of 65 kph near the center Gustiness of up to 80 kph
Movement	Northwest at 11 kph

Forecast Positions	<i>Wednesday morning</i> 610 km West Northwest of Dagupan City or at 580 km West of Laoag City
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No Public Storm Warning Signals Raised

With this development, this is the final bulletin for this weather disturbance.

In order to better inform/warn communities, you are reminded to disseminate these through local/community leaders and through your local media, including community radio stations. Conduct press briefings as often as needed. This local effort will complement and reinforce efforts at the national level. Emphasis should be on proactive actions – evacuation rather than rescue.
