#### I. Situation Overview

<b>Incident</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Fire started in a two storey house, made of wooden materials under GI sheet roofing owned by Mr. Felipe Saguisa Y Omadas, 47 y.o. native of Leyte (informal settlers)</li></ul>
<b>Time Fire Started</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• 1:27 PM, 20 July 2010</li></ul>
<b>Time of Fire Out</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• 4:00 PM, 20 July 2010</li></ul>
<b>Alarm Level</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• General Alarm</li></ul>
<b>Location</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Palanas area Brgy. Vasra, North Avenue, Quezon City</li></ul>
<b>Casualty</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• A certain Gerald Saguisa suffered a second degree burn on his right hand</li></ul>
<b>Damage/Effects</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• 100 houses/shanties / more or less 500 families (based on initial assessment)</li><li>• Two buildings – Annex 1 and 2 of the Department of Agriculture (DA) totally razed by the fire</li></ul>
<b>Estimated Cost of Damage</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• PhP7 M (DA Annex 1 and 2)</li></ul>
<b>Actions Taken</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• BFP responded to the fire incident</li><li>• Affected families housed at the Amphi Theater of Wildlife and immediately provided with relief goods (food and non-food items-mats, blankets, pails, soap) by the QC Social Services Development Department (SSDD)</li><li>• A community kitchen was also established by the QC SSDD</li><li>• QC SSDD will conduct a census today to determine the exact number of families/persons affected</li><li>• One (1) ambulance was placed on standby at the area</li><li>• City Health Office has set-up clinic within the evacuation area</li><li>• Some NGOs have also extended assistance to the evacuees</li><li>• Civil Defense Action Group (CDAG) fire truck provided water to the evacuation area</li><li>• DSWD NCR has coordinated with the local Social Services Development Department for augmentation of relief assistance to the fire victims</li></ul>
