### I. Situation Overview

Ranging from zero to eight hours (0-8 hrs) due to critical water level at Angat Dam, water shortage was experienced in the following areas under the Maynilad Water Services Inc., the water concessionaire in Metro Manila: Manila, Caloocan, Malabon, Pasay City, Parañaque, Quezon City and Navotas.

### II. Actions Taken

- ❖ Representatives from the City Government of Malabon – Office of the Mayor, Vice Mayor, City Administrator, Disaster Management Office, City Engineering, BFP Public Safety Office (PSTMO) and MWSI met to discuss and evaluate the situation and established contingency plan to address the imminent water crisis.
- ❖ Below are the measures that the city government will implement in close coordination with BFP and MWSI.
  - Deployment of fire trucks from the BFP and other fire volunteers to withdraw water from various Maynilad fire hydrants and pumping stations for distribution. Two (2) Maynilad water tankers shall distribute water to various barangays.
  - PSTMO and the Office of the Vice-Mayor assist in the identification of areas for distribution.
  - Office of the City Mayor thru the Disaster Management Office (DMO) continuously monitor and assess the situation and recommend appropriately.
  - Office of the City Mayor shall provide contingency funds for the same purpose.
  - Disseminate correct information for the public as regards to the situation and encourage their full cooperation.
- ❖ As of 5:00 PM 21 July 2010, BFP-NCR reported the following status of water rationing in some areas in Metro Manila specifically Maynilad's service area.

- ❖ Civil Defense Action Group (CDAG) deployed 5 tankers, 2 pumpers and 4 fire engines to augment the present water rationing in NCR.
- ❖ Per Maynilad, 45 barangays are without water supply (1 in Cavite, Las Piñas, 9 in Parañaque, 4 in Fairview Commonwealth, 13 in North Calocan, 9 in Quirino-Roosevelt, 5 in Novaliches-Valenzuela, 3 in Malabon-Navotas and 1 in South Caloocan) and:
- ❖ 112 barangays are with 1-6 hours water supply (24 in Sampaloc; 7 in Cavite-Las Piñas, 5 in Fairview Commonwealth, 24 in North Caloocan, 19 in Quirino-Roosevelt, 2 in Novaliches-Valenzuela, 9 in Malabon-Navotas and 12 in South Caloocan)
