SUBJECT : Severe Weather Bulletin No. 1 re: Tropical Depression "DOMENG"

1. OVERVIEW:

The Low Pressure Area (LPA) East of Bicol Region has developed into a Tropical Depression and was named, "Domeng"

Location of Center: (as of 4:00 p.m.)	500 kms East Northeast of Virac, Catanduanes
Coordinates:	15.2°N, 129.4°E
Strength	Maximum winds of 45 kph near the center
Forecast Positions	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• It is expected to be at 390 kms East of Virac, Catanduanes by tomorrow afternoon and at 300 kms Northeast of Virac, Catanduanes by Thursday afternoon• By Friday afternoon it is expected to be at 330 kms North of Virac, Catanduanes

The public and the disaster coordinating councils concerned are advised to take appropriate actions.

2. ACTIONS TAKEN:

- NDCC Advisory was disseminated to regions concerned through SMS and facsimile for further dissemination to their respective local disaster coordinating councils from the provincial down to the municipal levels


In order to better inform/warn communities, you are reminded to disseminate these through local/community leaders and through your local media, including community radio stations. Conduct press briefings as often as needed. This local effort will complement and reinforce efforts at the national level. Emphasis should be on proactive actions – evacuation rather than rescue.
