SUBJECT : Severe Weather Bulletin No. 2 re: Tropical Depression "DOMENG"

1. OVERVIEW:

Tropical Depression "Domeng" has accelerated slightly as it continues to move towards Northern Luzon

Location of Center: (as of 10:00 p.m.)	440 kms East Northeast of Virac, Catanduanes
Coordinates:	15.6°N, 128.6°E
Strength	Maximum winds of 45 kph near the center
Movement	To move Northwest at 11 kph
Forecast Positions	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• It is expected to be at 360 kms North Northeast of Virac, Catanduanes by tomorrow evening and at 430 kms North of Virac, Catanduanes or at 220 km East of Aparri, Cagayan by Thursday evening• By Friday evening, it is expected to be at 160 kms North of Aparri, Cagayan

The public and the disaster coordinating councils concerned are advised to take appropriate actions.

2. ACTIONS TAKEN:

- NDCC Advisory was disseminated to regions concerned through SMS and facsimile for further dissemination to their respective local disaster coordinating councils from the provincial down to the municipal levels


In order to better inform/warn communities, you are reminded to disseminate these through local/community leaders and through your local media, including community radio stations. Conduct press briefings as often as needed. This local effort will complement and reinforce efforts at the national level. Emphasis should be on proactive actions – evacuation rather than rescue.
