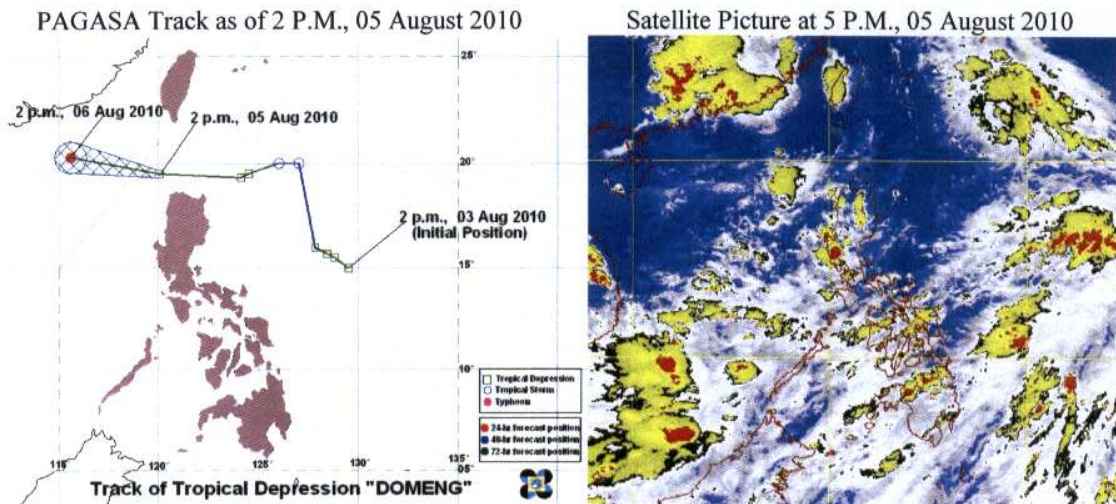

SUBJECT : Severe Weather Bulletin No. 8 re: Tropical Depression "DOMENG"

Tropical Depression "Domeng" has maintained its strength as it traverses the Balintang Channel on its way out to the South China Sea.



Location of Center: (as of 4:00 P.M.)	140 km Northwest of Laoag City
Coordinates:	19.5°N, 119.6°E
Strength:	Maximum sustained winds of 45 kph near the center
Movement:	Forecast to move West at 19 kph
Forecast Positions/Outlook:	<i>Friday afternoon</i> 510 km West Northwest of Laoag City

NO PUBLIC WARNINGS SIGNALS RAISED

Public Storm Warning Signal elsewhere is now lowered.

Meanwhile, the Low Pressure Area (LPA) was estimated based on satellite and surface data at 930 kms East of Northern Luzon (18.2°N, 132.0°E).

The combined effect of Tropical Depression “Domeng” and the Low Pressure Area East of Northern Luzon will enhance the Southwest Monsoon and bring rains over the country particularly the Western Section

Residents living in low lying and mountainous areas are alerted against possible flashfloods and landslides. Fisherfolks are also advised against venturing into municipal waters.

The public and the disaster coordinating councils concerned are advised to take appropriate actions.

In order to better inform/warn communities, you are reminded to disseminate these through local/community leaders and through your local media, including community radio stations. Conduct press briefings as often as needed. This local effort will complement and reinforce efforts at the national level. Emphasis should be on proactive actions – evacuation rather than rescue.
