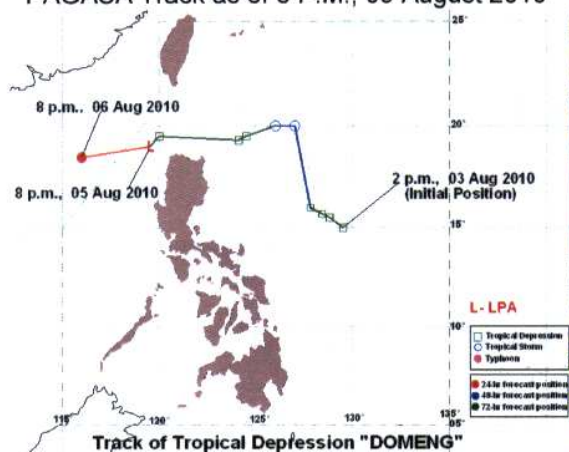

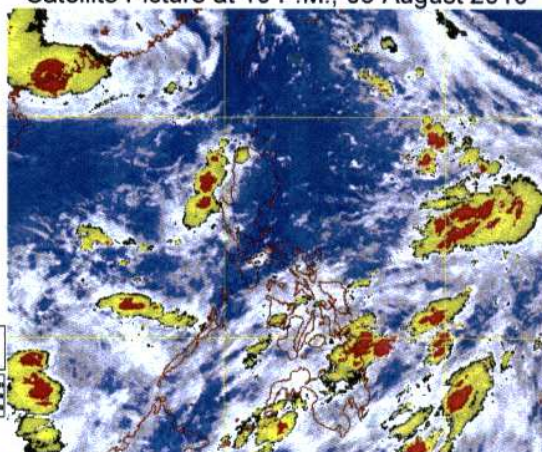

Tropical Depression "Domeng" has weakened into a Low Pressure Area (LPA) on its way out to the South China Sea.

NO PUBLIC STORM WARNING SIGNALS RAISED

Meanwhile, the Low Pressure Area (LPA) East of Luzon was estimated based on satellite and surface data at 840 kms East of Aparri, Cagayan (18.2°N, 130.5°E).

The two Low Pressure Areas are expected to continue to enhance the Southwest Monsoon and bring rains over the country particularly the western section.

With this development, this is the final bulletin for this weather disturbance.

Residents living in low lying and mountainous areas are alerted against possible flashfloods and landslides. Fisherfolks are also advised against venturing into municipal waters.

The public and the disaster coordinating councils concerned are advised to take appropriate actions.

In order to better inform/warn communities, you are reminded to disseminate these through local/community leaders and through your local media, including community radio stations. Conduct press briefings as often as needed. This local effort will complement and reinforce efforts at the national level. Emphasis should be on proactive actions – evacuation rather than rescue.
