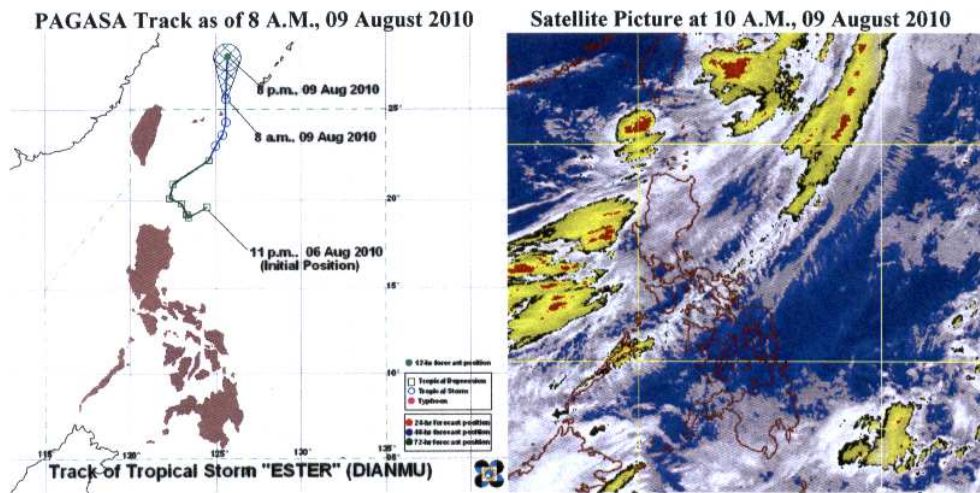

Tropical Storm "ESTER" further intensified further as it continues to move away from the country.



Location of Center: (as of 10:00 A.M.)	640 km North Northeast of Basco, Batanes
Coordinates:	25.9°N, 125.6°E
Strength:	Maximum winds of 95 kph near the center and gustiness of up to 120 kph
Movement:	North at 20 kph
Forecast Positions/Outlook:	<i>Monday evening:</i> 810 km North Northeast of Basco, Batanes or 240 km Northwest of Okinawa, Japan

All Public Storm Warning Signals are now lowered.

Tropical Storm "Ester" will continue to enhance the Southwest Monsoon and bring rains over Luzon and the coastal waters over these areas will be rough and dangerous to small seacrafts and fishing boats.

Residents in low lying and mountainous areas over the western sections of Northern and Central Luzon are alerted against possible flashfloods and landslides.

With this development, this is the final bulletin for this weather disturbance.

You are hereby directed to undertake precautionary measures in your AOR. Likewise, the public and Disaster Coordinating Councils (DCCs) concerned are advised to take appropriate actions.

Conduct press briefings as often as needed. This local effort will complement and reinforce efforts at the national level. Emphasis should be on proactive actions – evacuation rather than rescue.
